

CUFA Project Migration and Modernity – Historical and Cultural Challenges (MOVES) Wins a European Grant

A consortium of universities whose members include Charles University, University of Kent, Freie Universität Berlin, Université Paul Valéry, Montpellier III and Universidade do Porto has received a grant from the European Union as part of the scheme Horizon 2020, Marie Curie Skłodowska Actions – European Joint Doctorate, for its project *Migration and Modernity – Historical and Cultural Challenges* (MOVES).

The project coordinator is Professor Martin Procházka (Department of Anglophone Literatures and Cultures) and Faculty of Arts, Charles University, is the coordinating institution. The project has received 98% in the evaluation and will be supported for the period of four years.
