

Call for Proposals (Date created: December 2017)



Scholarship for International Summer Course (German) for students / doctoral researchers from partner universities of Heinrich Heine University (HHU)

Who is eligible?

B.A. and M.A. students and doctoral researchers enrolled at a university abroad with which a Cooperation Agreement exists either on university, faculty or departmental level.

What is the objective of the scholarship?

To strengthen international partnerships in all faculties through exchange of students / doctoral researchers. To provide an opportunity to improve German language proficiency by means of a 2- to 4-week stay at HHU.

Which conditions must be fulfilled?

1. Nominees of the partner university must be educational foreigners.
2. The nominee takes part in a 2- or 4-week course phase in August.

Scale and duration of funding

The scholarship covers:

- Language course costs for up to 4 weeks
- An additional € 300 allowance towards rent/living expenses

 No prolongation possible.

Who nominates the candidates?

Each partner university selects a candidate in accordance with HHU's criteria and nominates him/her to HHU.

What should be the nomination criteria?

The selection of the candidate should contribute to the strengthening of the partnership.

Who decides?

The final selection is made by a selection committee at HHU.

What kind of German courses are offered?

Elementary, intermediate and advanced:
Level A2 to C1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). Please note: No courses for absolute beginners (Level A1) - you have already had approx. 200 hours of German classes. Please note: It is possible to gain 2 ECTS per 2 weeks (40 hours) and 4 ECTS for 4 weeks.
