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Latin Synchronic Morphology and Linguistic Theory

A brief general overview of what is currently intended as a synchronic morphology of Classical Latin, from the perspective of generative linguistics. In particular, it will be discussed the problem of the basic units of the morphological system and the representation of the lexical rules.

Problems of Analysis of Latin Infinitival Clauses

The relatively strong character of Latin infinitival morphology has widespread consequences on the entire architecture of the infinitival clauses, in particular on the structural configuration which allows the assignment of accusative case to the subject of an infinitive.
