# Language and Culture COMMUNICATION ACROSS CULTURES

You are cordially invited to the annual International Meeting of Young Linguists. The conference boasts a 16 years' tradition which started in 2000 at the Institute of the Czech Language of the Academy of Sciences, Prague, and has been continued since 2001 at Palacký University in Olomouc. The topics to be discussed this year are the following:

The concept of *intercultural communication* emerged as a topic of academic discussions in 1950s (cf. E. T. Hall 1959). In the field of modern Czech (socio)linguistics, the intercultural communication has been defined (cf. Lehmanová 1999) as a reflection of communication processes among the subjects whose cognitive and emotional structures, as well as the perception and assessment of the reality, are determined by different cultural backgrounds.

Due to globalisation, increasing migration of the world population, and so called "crisis of multiculturalism", the issues of interculturality, transculturality and cultural syncretism are becoming more and more important in the present-day Europe.

- What is a role of various linguistic disciplines (contrastive and intercultural linguistics, ethnolinguistics) in the discussion on the intercultural communication?
- Is the communication across cultures just about a face-to-face communication between the members of different cultures, or more about its medialization?
- Do the diverse forms of communication tend to adapt to any intercultural norms? Or do we build an inventory of "intercultural" meanings shared within a diversified cultural domain?
