Job title: Associate Professor

Field and specialization: Sociology

Expected pay group: AP3

Expected part-time or full-time position (20 – 40 hours per week)

Job description:

- teaching subjects in Sociology at all levels of study and within the applicant's specialization will be expected
- supervision of students' projects and theses
- conducting independent research program within the applicant's areas of expertise

Job requirements:

- Associate Professor or Professor in sociology, alternatively in related subject field (applications of applicants with initiated habilitation procedures may also be accepted)
- adequate teaching experience
- opportunity to teach in English
- adequate publication record in the field of specialization
- PI experience in research projects and grants
- organizational and communication skills

Application deadline: **November 19, 2018**


Complete applications will include the following:

- letter of motivation with subject orientation proposal: preferred topics of courses and research projects, other ways of participation in academic life
- curriculum vitae
- overview of teaching experience
- complete list of publications
- copies of documents that show academic degrees awarded
